Where is Rennebohm Park? Is there parking?

115 N. Eau Claire Avenue on Madison's near west side.

Directions: Take Midvale Blvd to Regent Street, go west on Regent to Eau Claire Ave.

- Street parking on Regent Street, side streets.
- Off-street parking in the parkland. Please park in straight lines to allow maximum cars. The driveway itself must be kept open for emergency vehicles.
- Buses park on the east side of the bike path.
- The parkland may or may not be open on days of very heavy rain.
